**Developmental Works Inspection for water supply in Guntur**

Engineering Officers of Municipal Corporation have verified and checked the Water Supply System at Undavalli and Mangalagiri to ensure that in coming summer there should not be any water issues in Guntur. Firstly, they checked the work of 1600 pipelines by Intec well, which is funded by World Bank at Undavalli. Stress was laid on the works at Railway Level Crossing and must be done fast without negligence. By the end of February, the Guntur channel will get closed and later this Mangalagiri Pipeline will get in to work hence in should be cleaned. Upon inspecting the motor working at Mangalgiri it was found occupied and which is to be bought in the notice of municipal commissioner immediately.



**Commissioner’s Outdoor Inspection**

City Commissioner Ms S Naga Lakshmi S, IAS went for the inspection to Lakshmiapuram, Vishnu Nagar, Dwarka Nagar, Bapaiah Nagar, Vijayapuri Colony, S.V.N Colony, Pedha Palakaluru, NGO Colony and Kaakani to verify Occupancy Certificates and Ventures and granted permissions per the rules. Commissioner stressed that; Officers in charge must check the wards where the construction work is going on and restrict unauthorised work. At the same time, Apartment Construction people must not allow the ramps on to Drains and Roads, and People of Apartments must install Soak Pits and Greenery in their Premises. City Planner Sri Dhanunjay Reddy, A.C.P Smt. Surekha, T.P.S Sri Venkateshwara Rao, Sri Srinivas Rao, Building Inspectors also participated.

### **Plastic Ban in Guntur**

Municipal Corporation formed a Special Team on the orders of City Commissioner for taking actions on Plastic Bag Manufacturers and also on Consumers. This Special Team investigated in Lalapet, Patnam Bazar, Hazaru vaari Street area shops, Whole Sale shops, bakeries, hotels and pulling carts. The investigation revealed 80kg Plastic bags and penalty of 12,300/- was charged, team ordered to use only 50+ microns white plastic bags and should not use 50- microns plastic bags. If caught using or selling these plastic bags, firstly penalty will be charged later on secondly serious actions will be taken according to rules and the D&O trade license will be cancelled. Later on instructions like do not throw any kind of plastic in Drainage. That is harmful to the atmosphere. Hazardous to health. People should use Jute bags, Paper bags and Cloth Bags so that no harm will be done to atmosphere were given by the team.



### **Swatchhatha App Installation Initiative**

Municipal Commissioner asked people to Install Swatchhatha App on their mobile phone to make Guntur as a Clean City. People have to inform about the problems about cleanliness. On this occasion, Dr. Ramesh Hospital Management has come forward to install the app first to show their support. At the program, Dr. Ramesh has spoken that through this app People will tell issues regarding the Cleanliness to the Municipal Corporation.

City Commissioner S Naga Lakshmi asked students to download and install the new app “Swatchhatha App”. On the occasion, Vignan Engineering College organised Nirulotsav and City Commissioner was attended as Chief Guest. City Commissioner. Ms. Nagalakshmi S. IAS said that Students must have their Goals, and must keep effort for those goals, have maximum Social Responsibility. Commissioner also said that Guntur was chosen as Amruth Padhakam and also conducting Swachha Sarvekshan in city. In the survey, Guntur must occupy top place within 10 ranks in India Level. The Survey mainly focuses on Online Services, Cleanliness and Wastage. After completing the Survey, based on the marks ranks will be awarded, so people should install the app and support the city.



### **Guntur Under Ground Drainage Project**

Guntur Commissioner Ms Naga Lakshmi S. IAS conducted a meeting where they discussed about Under Ground Drainage with budget 960 Crores in Guntur. The Guttedar organisation Shapoorji Pallonji, public Health, Municipal Corporation Engineering and City Development Officers have participated in the meeting. Guntur Parliament member Sri Galla Jayadev has said that 150 years have been completed and now implementing this Drainage System this year is very Prestigious. The Project costs 500 crores provided by Central Government and 300 crores provided by State Government. The project will start soon and assuming to complete in 2019. Guttedar said they will complete in 2018. Considering that the city is in Capital region, so the Drainage System must go well. The Project includes two stages, Sewage Treatment Plant and Installation of Sewage Lines. On completing 150 years of Guntur Municipal Corporation, they are planning to construct a Six Lane Road on Sankarvilas Bridge and are going to discuss with Delhi Central Railways. East Legislative Member Mr. Sheik Musthafa have spoken that the Dreams Project should complete with in the period. On this occasion, City Commissioner has asked to design UGD that 92% of people's needs must satisfy.



### **Poster free Guntur**

Under this initiative the Collectorate office compound wall has been painted by the students of the KITS college of Engineering and technology. The students who volunteered from the college worked enthusiastically. The programme was inaugurated by the Collectorate Sri.Kantilal Dande, in the presence of Commissioner Guntur Municipal Corporation Ms. Nagalakshmi S. IAS.
