Smart Waste Management Machine

To produce organic fertilizer from wet waste, AP government is trying to use Smart waste management system. In this connection a trail run was held on 14th June in Chandramouli Nagar. This smart waste management machine will cost only 20 thousand rupees which will convert all the domestic wet waste into pesticide for plants. As residential apartments produce a huge quantity of wet waste every day, this machine will be very useful for them. Commissioner GMC Smt. C Anuradha attended the demonstration programme and said that every apartment was suggested to buy this machine so that wet waste will not pollute the environment and also be useful to maintain plants. This machine will help residential apartments to arrange their own roof garden for growing vegetables, flowers and decorative plants etc. This machine takes 20 days to prepare organic fertilizer. If every residential apartment procures this mechanism, they can not only grow their own vegetables, but also can save transport expenses to corporation.



Face Lifting of Anganwadi centers

For the face lifting of anganwadi centers in Guntur, work has been started as the necessary material like chairs, tables, benches and the walls have been painted to enhance the aesthetics of the anganwadi centers of Guntur Municipal Corporation. In Guntur there are 321 anganawadi centers, to uplift the anganwadi ceters to 3 centers are merged into one to make them functional and work in a proper manner. Under face uplifting of the anganwadi centers 10 centers have been on pilot basis and all the facilities have been provided. The work on next 7 centers is under progress. Commissioner Guntur Municipal Corporation Smt. C Anuradha instructed the officials to work in a congenial manner so that Anganwadi centers of GMC will be model in whole state.



Vanam Manam Programme

Vanam Manam Programme has been celebrated in the Guntur Corporation by planting trees and plants in the city. On this occasion saplings were distributed among the citizens of Guntur and also planted on the different locations of the city. MLA West Guntur Mr. Modugula Venugopala Reddy participated in the programme and said that plants act as a remedial step to curb pollution, they provide clean air hence more and more plants ought to be planted. Commissioner Guntur Municipal Corporation Smt. C Anuradha said during this year the target for plantation is 50,000 trees in Guntur. She also directed the engineering staff to carry out the work of plantation as soon as possible.



Black Spot Monitoring and Management

Black spot monitoring in the state became a best practice to keep the state of Andhra Pradesh clean. In GMC limits, black spots are being noted and photographs before and after cleaning the black spot are being uploaded to DMA control room. Commissioner, GMC Smt. C Anuradha conducted a meeting with sanitary inspectors on this issue and laid stress on attendance of sanitation staff before and after the shift timings. Sanitation trucks trip details, black spot details should be updated regularly and if needed, more trips will also be allotted, commissioner added.



Upgradation of Municipal Schools

Monitoring basic amenities in Corporation schools like sports facilities, teachers efficiency, staff requirement, toilet status, electricity position is leading the keep GMC schools in top position. Commissioner in a review of the amenities on 15th June said that school principals should send frequent updates on the above said amenities to corporation especially teachers list should be considered as top priority. Sports equipments, play grounds should also be considered as a priority issue, as physical exercise are very much needed to the students, commissioner added.



Development of Koritepadu Park under AMRUT

To improve the quality of life in the city, Koritepadu Park has been taken to be developed under the AMRUT scheme in SAAP 2015-16. The park is developed keeping into consideration the children of the area. The children play equipment has been put there so as to provide the children the place to enjoyment. Apart from that the park is developed to give the leisure time to the residents and the greenery gives the fresh air and at the same time refreshes the air. A small open air theatre and walking tracks are also provided there so that it will be attractive to all walks of life.
